

Spectator/Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct:

As parents/guardians/spectators of youth soccer I will conform my conduct to meet and match the standards set forth below:

- I will follow the <u>Wisconsin Youth Soccer Zero Tolerance Policy</u>
- I will practice the guidelines for sidelines behavior as outlined in the <u>Wisconsin Youth</u> Soccer Guidelines for Sideline Behavior.
- I will not yell at, question, or approach a referee/official ever
- I will not coach my child or other children from the sideline. My comments will be limited to cheering the players on.
- I will practice good sportsmanship to all players on the field, the coaches, the referees, and the opponent's spectators
- Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat
- Respect the integrity and judgement of the officials
- Discuss concerns directly with the coach first, but only after a 24 cooling off periods to ensure emotions don't run too high.
 - o If issues are not addressed, I may bring the issue to the board for resolution.
- Understand injuries may happen in the game and that the referee does not have to stop the game if a player is injured.
- Understand that injuries are not always the result of a foul.
- I understand that even if my child is injured, I may never go onto the fields of play.
- Finally, I understand that failing to follow any of these points may result in a ban in watching the games.
